The PTR settlement webinar was held yesterday. Below are the highlights of everything we covered for anyone who was unable to attend or missed some of the presentation.

When you type in your EIN, we have added two additional columns that show the status of your payment and the pay period it was submitted. The statuses will be shown as Newly Submitted, Pending and Paid.



- **Paid:** You have been processed and paid by the Payroll System
- **Newly Submitted:** Labor Relation has recently submitted your information to Payroll for payment.
- **Pending:** Your information has not been submitted to Payroll by Labor Relations

We will update the payment status every two weeks, the Thursday before USPS payday. Please check the website to see if there have been any changes to your payment status.

Former Employees/ Retirees

If you no longer are employed by the USPS, your payment will be sent to the last post office in which you were employed. If your status says paid, please reach out to the manager at your last postal office or your local president to inquire about your check or send me an email at maintwebinar@apwu.org to investigate with Payroll on your behalf.

50 Full-time Regular Conversions

If you are interested in becoming a full-time custodian, please email maintwebinar@apwu.org and provide your **location, name, the number of hours you currently work**, and whether you want to be converted to a regular custodian or a building maintenance custodian. It's going to be around 50 positions nationwide that will be converted to full-time.
