Trump's 2025 Executive
Order declaring
Christmas Eve (Dec. 24)
and Dec. 26 as
federal holidays

DOES NOT APPLY

to the United States Postal Service

The Postal Service remains operational on those days except for Christmas Day itself.

While USPS is a federal agency, historically and in this instance, USPS post offices remain open for retail services on Christmas Eve and December 26. Mail delivery also continues on these two dates.

The USPS only closes on Christmas Day itself for both retail and mail service. Thus, the agency's operational schedule on Dec. 24 and 26 does not fully align with the federal government-wide closure dictated by the executive order.

Summary:

- · USPS post offices are open, and mail delivery continues on these days.
- Christmas Day remains the USPS holiday closure.
- The order affects federal employees generally but does not impose closure on USPS operations beyond Christmas Day.

This distinction reflects USPS's role as an essential service that often continues to operate even when other federal offices close.
